- Uses GENViewer CD-ROM <http://www.mudcreeksoftware.com/>
- Same company has GENViewer Lite, a free program for viewing GEDCOM files
- I also put a copy of the file in Family Tree Maker format in case the person has that program
- GENCOMs don't support Pictures and Documents

#### Pictures

- Folder for pictures

#### Documents

- Folder for support documents like birth certificates and census

#### Reports

- Folder for reports generated from Family Tree Maker

#### Web Site and Contact Info

- Use web page for documenting where the file is on-line and my email address

#### Help

- Use web page for help with Menu program
