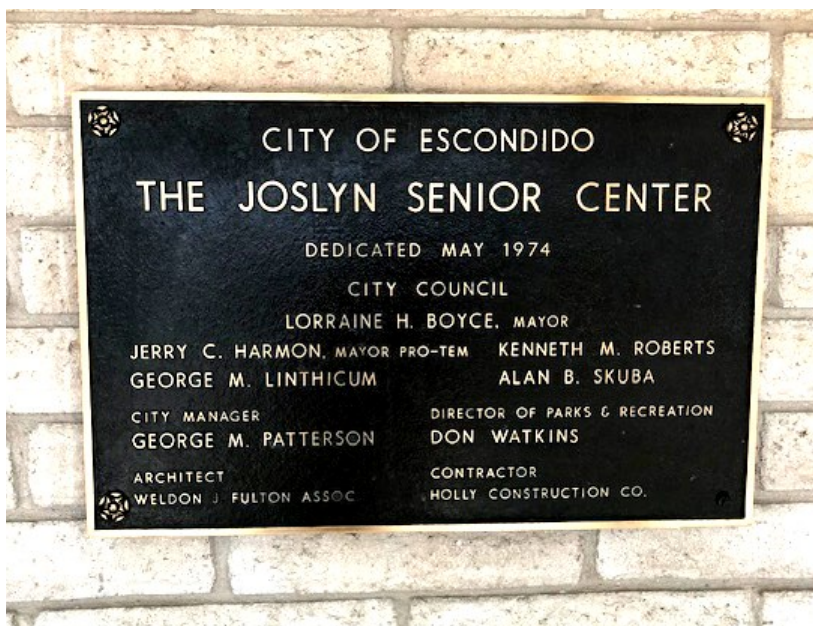
Sid Shapira will be our speaker, she will do a presentation on how to write your family story for future generations

EGS September 2021 Meeting



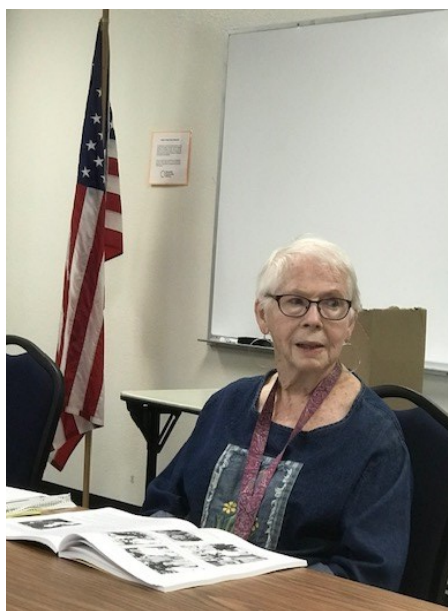
Ruth Wehner brought a wedding dress, worn by her aunt, Edna (Francis) Crim, at her wedding in October 1922.
